

Short biography for CORROSION2019

Damien Féron is Director of Research at the Nuclear Energy Division of the French Atomic Energy and Alternative Energies Commission (CEA) and Professor at the INSTN (National Institute for Nuclear Science and Technology). He is working in the field of nuclear corrosion since nearly 40 years.

He is editor or co-editor of 17 books or special issues of journals, mainly in the field of biocorrosion, seawater corrosion and nuclear corrosion.

Damien Féron chaired the “Science and Technology Advisory Committee” of the European Federation of Corrosion (EFC) between 2007 and 2013, and he has been President of the EFC (2017-18). He is Vice-President of the WCO (World Corrosion Organization).

Damien Féron received the « Grande Médaille » of CEFACOR (Centre français de l’anticorrosion) in 2007 and the « Honorary Fellow » Honor of NACE (USA) in 2009. He has been nominated “Chevalier dans l’ordre des Palmes Académiques” (French National Honor) in 2017.
